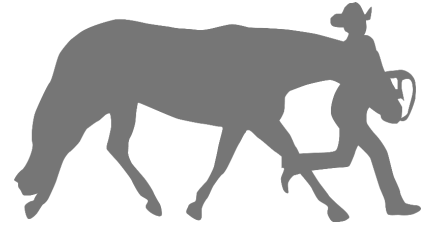

2024 MQHA SHOW INFORMATION

- Shows will take place at the Princess Louise Show Center in Sussex, NB. Classes may be held in the indoor or outdoor arena, at the show office's discretion. A warmup arena is available. The cattle penning arena is also available, provided the cattle penning club is not using it.
- Exhibitors must be ready for their class when the class is called. After the gate is shut, you will not be permitted to enter.
- Horses coming for early arrival may arrive anytime after 12:00pm on Wednesday. For horses arriving Thursday, you may arrive after 8:00am.
- Do not place anything in any stall that does not belong to you, including your horse, your hay, buckets, your tack etc. Any unauthorized stall usages will be charged a daily stall rate.
- Horses may be shown off the trailer. You must notify us at least 2 days in advance if this is your intention, and we will arrange for a safe place for you to park your truck and trailer.
- YOU MUST SEND IN REGISTRATION PAPERS, AQHA MEMBERSHIP, PROOF OF INSURANCE, SIGNED WAIVER AND LEVEL 1 ELIGIBILITY IF SHOWING IN ANY L1 CLASSES.** These only need to be sent one time/season, unless an AQHA membership has expired in which case you will need to send your updated card.
- MQHA MEMBERSHIP MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU SHOW IF YOU WISH FOR YOUR POINTS TO COUNT FOR YEAR END AWARDS. MQHA MEMBERSHIP IS ALSO REQUIRED TO SHOW IN FUTURITIES for both the horse owner and the exhibitor.**
- Patterns will be posted on MQHA's website at least one week prior to the show. Exhibitors are to print & bring their own patterns.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to accurately complete the entry form & for the exhibitor to know the AQHA rules, and only to enter classes that they are eligible for.
- The show office will be open on Thursday from 1:00pm-7:00pm and Friday to Monday from 7:00am until show day is finished.
- Stall and hookup bookings information is posted on maritimeqha.com under the events page. Deposits will only be refunded with a vet or doctors note.
- Shavings are to be pre-ordered and will be added to your show bill. If not pre-ordered you must coordinate with & pay PLP directly.
- Entries must be received by midnight on July 19th. Entries received after this will be subject to a \$40.00+HST late fee. No exceptions.**
- Payment can be made by cheque, cash, e-transfer or credit card. Credit card payments will be subject to a 3.5% service charge. **Payments must be received in full before you leave the show.**
- AQHA Rules will prevail in all classes as set forth in the 2024 AQHA Rule Book. See futurity rules for exceptions.
- You may post enter a class up to 3 classes before, except for Futurity Classes. **Futurity Classes must be post entered by 7:00PM the night before the class. No exceptions.**
- Please notify the gate person or show office at least 3 classes ahead if you need to scratch from a class.
- Tack stalls and stalls for non-showing horses may be available if space permits. Our first priority is to use them

for the horses who are showing. If space permits the rate is the same as the regular stall fee.

- Ribbons or alternate prizes (cups etc) are available for 1st thru 6th place. They are placed at the ingate to be picked up by the exhibitor. Futurity class ribbons are handed out in the ring. 1st place futurity winners shall have their picture taken for the class sponsor.
- High Point Awards:** All classes in the respective divisions will count towards the high point. For walk/jogs it will be the walk/jog halter & showmanship classes that count. Halter to count for ranch.

In the case of a tie, the horse with the most first will win.

- High Point Prizes will not be mailed.** They must be picked up at the office before you leave the showgrounds.

Futurities:

Futurities follow AQHA rules, with exceptions of open competitors being allowed to show in the 2/3 year old walk/jog series.

Payouts: For add back classes 60% of entry fees will be added onto the payout.

Payouts Percentages: 1st – 38%, 2nd – 22%, 3rd – 15%, 4th – 11%, 5th – 8%, 6th – 6%

Non Pro – As defined by AQHA all youth and amateurs are considered to be non-pros.

Year Long Showmanship Series – Your top 8 scores from the season will count. Ties will be broken by the most first places. These will be awarded and paid out at the Year End Banquet. You must choose between the regular non-pro and the walk/jog; you cannot show in both futurities. To be eligible for the walk/jog, you must not be showing in any canter/loping classes for the duration of the show.

2/3 Year Old Walk Jog – All exhibitors are permitted to show in this class, including open competitors. The horse must not be shown in any loping classes for the duration of the show, Your top 8 scores from the season will count. Ties will be broken by the most first places. These will be awarded and paid out at the Year End Banquet.
